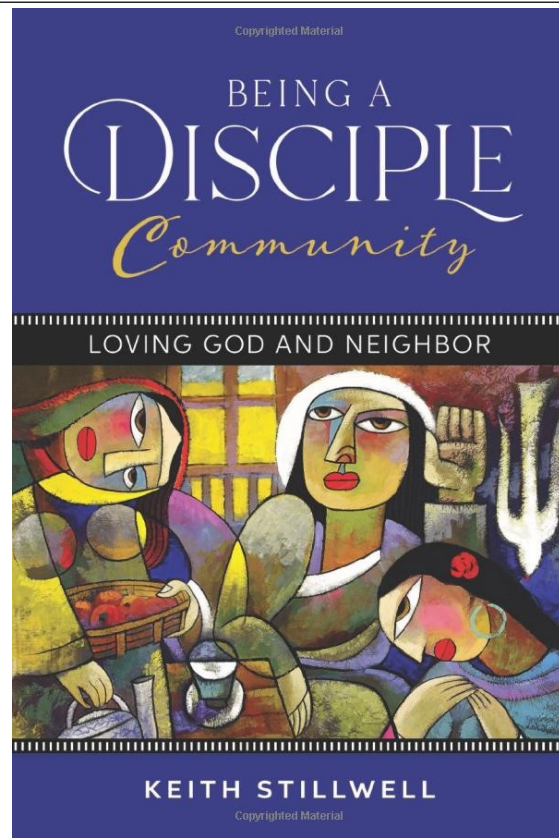


WMU® God's mission.

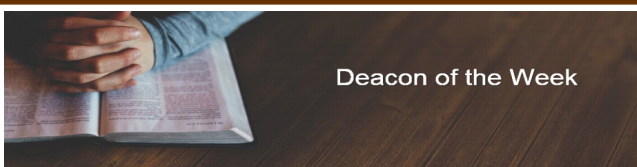

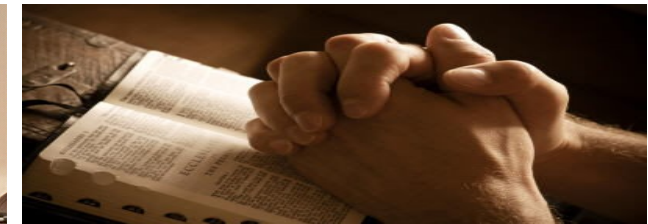
