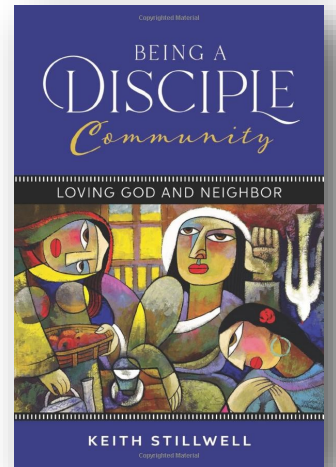

I have found working through Keith Stillwell's book, Being A Disciple Community to be a personally renewing experience. Having the opportunity to fashion a teaching plan for our Facebook® broadcast, as well as being able to engage in conversation with other members of our church on Wednesday evenings has given me the time and space to reflect on the life and work of the church in general, and of our church in particular.

After the introductory session, our first subject dealt with the definition, nature, and role of *community* in disciple formation, as well as disciple living. Keith's emphasis on the community as the arena in which we are both formed as disciples and from which we live out our calling as Jesus' disciples was affirming and challenging. Over the 23 years I have been a part of Lyndon, the nature of our community has changed dramatically, as we have seen people and groups of people come and go.

Today, when we gather on Sundays, we are more diverse, in so many ways, than we have been. Our congregation gathers people from all over globe to worship and serve together. In addition to the ethnic diversity, we reflect a broader diversity of ages than we have in while; we are not just a congregation of older people. Recently we have seen a surge in children under the age of 12 as a regular part of our gathering.

While this is exciting, it is also challenging. The question we need to continue to ask ourselves is 'how can our life together as a community of Jesus' disciples reflect in spirit and in practice the diversity of our fellowship?'

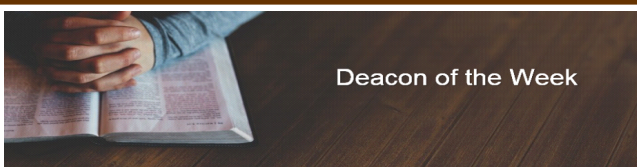

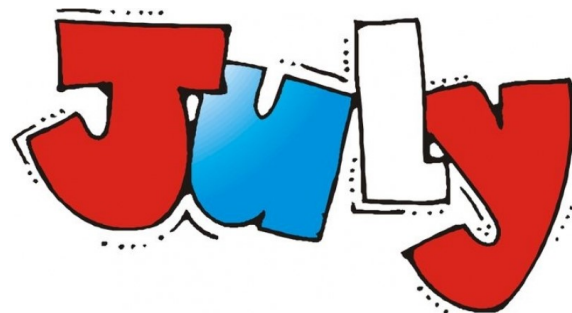
