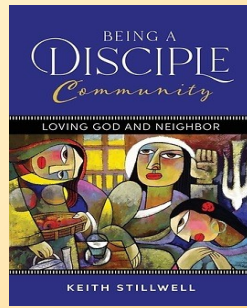

The Epistle reading for this Sunday, Romans 8:26-39, is one of my favorite passages of Scripture. Paul's words have been a source of strength and hope for me in some of the most difficult times of my life. Perhaps the power of Paul's proclamation comes from the fact that he reminds me that God's love is not conditional. It does not depend upon the circumstance around me. It does not even depend on whether I have lived a life deserving of God's love.

Chapter 8 of Romans begins with these words, "There is, therefore, no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death."

In the words of the passage we read on Sunday, Paul sums up the argument of the whole chapter, which is basically that Spirit of God gives us life and hope at all times, but especially when life is hard.

Reflect on what Paul says about the way the Spirit mediates God's love:

- ◆ Even when we have trouble praying, the Spirit is already praying with and for us;
- ◆ God is a work in **all** (not some but all) circumstances for our good;
- ◆ Because God did not withhold Jesus, we can be assured that God's judgement is rooted in love;
- ◆ Therefore, we live with confidence, not fear, because "nothing can separate us from the love of God." Amen and Amen.

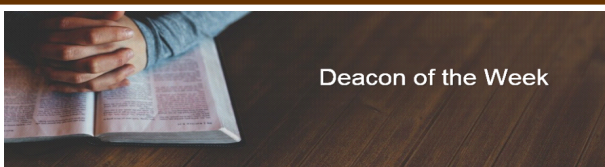

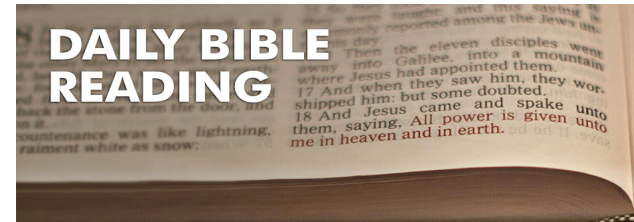

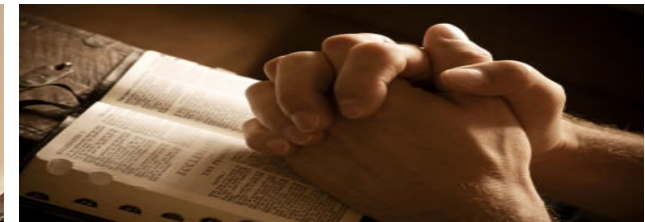
PRAYER GUIDE
