I will be travelling to the Sisters of Loretto Motherhouse in Nerinx, KY to spend time alone in one of their "Cedars of Peace" retreat cabins

The time there will be spent doing simply resting. And as odd as it may sound that rest will not be passively sleeping or lolling about, but will take place while following a rhythm each day: rising at a certain time for prayer and meditation, spending time enjoying the nature in which I will be immersed, reading, journaling, worshipping with the nuns who live there, and taking time for quietly listening to God.

I have no strategic set of practical outcomes for this week other than to spend time in God's green pastures, beside God's still waters, seeking to restore my spirit and to deepen my understanding of God's calling to me as a disciple of Jesus Christ and one whom God has called to be a pastor/teacher in the church.

I know when I arrive there next week, I will be one of several people on retreat whom the Sisters who live there will put on their prayer list. They have no idea why any of us are there, but they pray for us anyway, that God will encounter us in those places where we need mending, strengthening, and a deeper sense of who we are in the life of God.

I hope you will pray for me as well.

I am looking forward to this time alone with God; a time with no distractions, no schedules, and hopefully, no crises. When I have taken these retreats in the past, I have come away from them both challenged and at peace. Thank you for allowing me the time and space.

PRAYER FOR THE MUSLIM WORLD

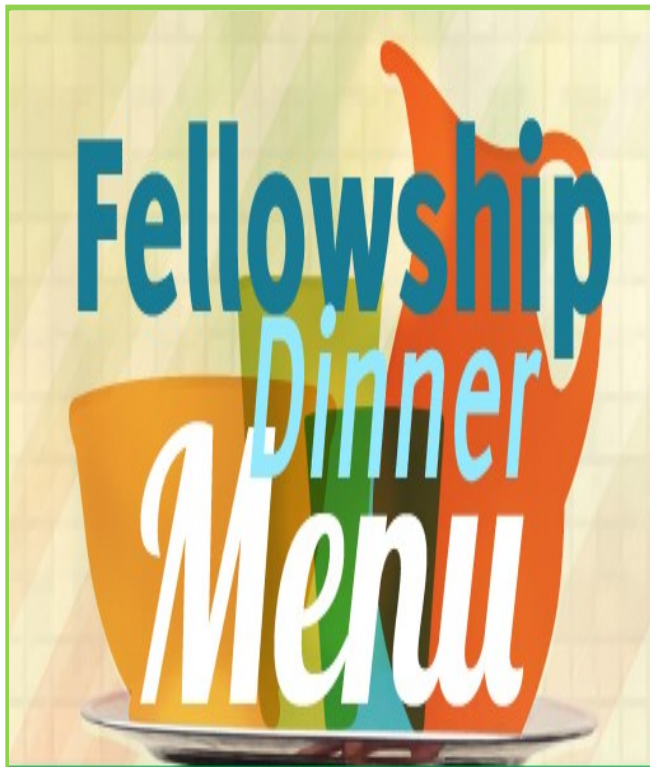
Pray for the training of house church leaders as they are equipped to provide spiritual direction in their communities.
