Plans are well underway for the 2023 Baptist Habitat House Build. Since 1998 a group of Baptist churches in Louisville have banded together to build homes with lower-income persons in our city. Over the past 25 years, this consortium of Baptist churches had built 30 homes. This year's will be our 31st.

This year, we will be joining our money time and talent with five (5) other Baptist churches -- Broadway, First Baptist Middletown, Highland, Melbourne Heights, and Westport Road to build a home with Va'Que Dennis.

Va'Que is a young man whose professional football career was cut short by a knee injury. He currently works as an Assistant Manager at a local Jimmy John's. He has hopes of going back to school to prepare for a career in graphic desing. Lyndon Baptist Church has committed to support this annual project with our money, our time, and our talents. This year's house is located in the Shively area on Shagbark Road.

The RAISE THE ROOF DAYS are Thursday, March 9th, Friday, March 10th, and Saturday, March 11th. The goal of RAISE THE ROOF DAYS is to have the house completely under roof, with doors and windows installed.

Lyndon is planning for a group of 2-3 people to participate on Thursday, with an additional 5-6 people to participate on-site Saturday, 8 a.m. -2:30 p.m. We are looking for volunteers, no matter your skill level.

The church will also be providing lunch on Friday, at noon, as we have done in previous years. Additional workdays will be arranged as the building of the house progresses. Anyone over 18 years of age is welcome to be a part of this special project.

Case Management – assisting people experiencing housing and job insecurity to receive benefits, find housing, and apply for jobs.

Christmas Boxes for Appalachia – 2800 boxes were delivered this year in Laurel County, McCreary County, and Scott County in Tennessee.
